You will choose 3 songs from the packet

- Identify all Transcendental characteristics in each song
- Provide text evidence (a quote that expresses that characteristic)

When you finish 3 songs, bring them to me so I can check them off, then you can work on assignments you haven't turned in yet. **3 songs on back:** you can take this home and complete additional analysis for up to 3 of your own songs. Those 3 will be extra credit and due Monday. (the 3 required **MUST** be finished today! If you don't get them checked, they will be considered late!)

You can sit next to and talk to whomever you want, but you may **NOT** use the same songs. If you use the same songs, you will be given a different song next week and will have to rewrite. So make sure you are choosing different songs! I don't need to warn you about whether or not you can or cannot use the same song!
